orientaciones de una narrativa sujeta a continuas renovaciones pese a ello la rica variedad temática la exhuberancia en el uso del lenguaje y la constante presencia en las obras de una imaginación ilimitada que muestra lo que de maravilloso existen en la realidad americana justifican en parte el uso de este apelativo

how did it happen that whole regions of latin america amazonia patagonia the caribbean are named for monstrous races of women warriors big footed giants and cannibals through history monsters inhabit human imaginings of discovery and creation and also degeneration chaos and death latin america's most dynamic monsters can be traced to archetypes that are found in virtually all of the world's sacred traditions but only in latin america did amazons cannibals zombies and other monsters become enduring symbols of regional history character and identity from amazons to zombies presents a comprehensive account of the qualities of monstrosity the ways in which monsters function within and among cultures and theories and genres of the monstrous it describes the genesis and evolution of monsters in the construction and representation of latin america from the ancient world and early modern iberia to the present

a turbulent decade remembered studies the 1960s the continental moment that marked latin america s full entry into both modernity and post modernity in the international arena delving into scenes of importance for the intersection of aesthetics and politics the book addresses the impact of the cuban revolution on the imagination of the decade the student movements of 1968 in their international context and the tragic events of tlatelolco memorialized in different ways by mexico s greatest intellectuals in examining the construction of the great novels usually identified as the boom the book revises the critical tradition established since the late sixties rethinking the oft cited magical realism while considering the role of the press prizes gendered networks of solidarity and competition and the emergence of a literary star system the implications of all these forces of the republic of letters are set in dialogue with an analysis of the major novels of the decade with particular attention to their literary craft their manipulation of space voice and varied readerships

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
